a phase of the moon indicator (black circular object at mid-point in the wood enclosed area). Much of the long run time comes from the super efficiency (reduced friction) of the movement. Fabulous workmanship! Phil will enter the clock in the competition at the National Convention in Milwaukee in June 2014.

Many thanks go to all those who helped plan and carry out our party.


