The 2014 Pacific Northwest Regional will soon be here! On May 15 — 17, at the fully remodeled Hotel Murano in Tacoma, we will enjoy the latest version of our local Regional. We are back in Tacoma, and again have the traditional May dates!

Featured Speakers

Our Keynote address Thursday evening—after Mart setup and hors d’oeuvres, will be given by Dennis Radage on the subject of English Horology, and will accompany our themed English exhibit. Dennis is a Star Fellow of the NAWCC and is a Freeman and Liveryman of the UK based Worshipful Company of Clockmakers.

Our Luncheon speaker is (Chapter 50 member) Brittany Cox, a North Seattle Community College watch program grad, and English trained restorer/conservator.

Brittany graduated from the West Dean College in UK, and has worked at some European Museums and for Bonhams and others. She will discuss some of her restoration projects.

John Connolly, currently President of BC Chapter 121, member of Ch168—400 Day Chapter, and formerly with the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, has lived in Hong Kong and has traveled extensively in China. John will speak at our Banquet on the subject of the Chinese Emperor's Clocks.

Mini-Universities

Steve Nelson, a regular contributor to the Bulletin Technical Tidbits, will give 2 programs on burnishing Vienna Regulator pivots and on his work in horological oils.

Robert Simon, a past president of a Pittsburgh chapter and contributor to the Bulletin, will present a program on Bank Safe Time Clocks.

Phil Johansen, a local true innovator and Ch. 50 member, will discuss a new idea he has for a chiming train based on a Roman Numeral counting system and involves 3 bells.

Tom Payne, a longtime Ch. 50 member, Northwest School of Horology instructor and local repair shop owner, will review the Atmos clock and demonstrate removal and installation of a bellows.

Norm Nelson, Ch. 50 member and tool enthusiast, will discuss another concept in lathe collets that is an alternative to the standard collets in use today.
